3.1 Financial Assistance from the college:

During this academic year,

- 78 students who are either from economically poor background or be a sports player have been benefited the sum of Rs. 1,60,000/- from **REEPS** (Rural Educational Endowment for Poor Students) scholarship.

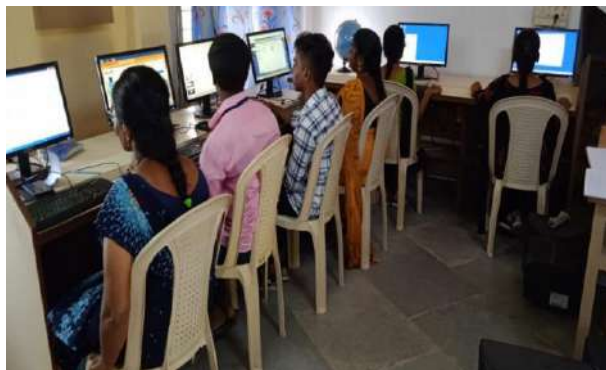

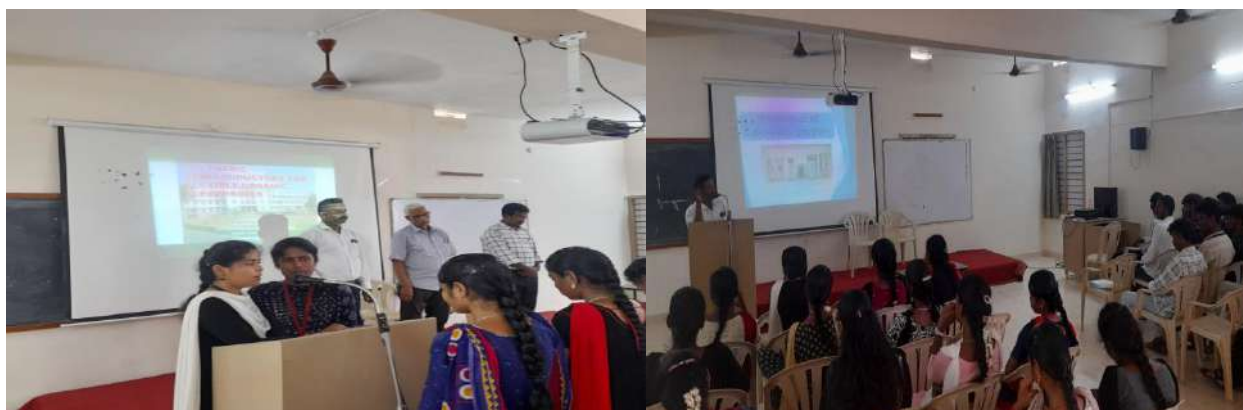
ASSOCIATION MEETING -II
